

CITIZEN NOTICE

Regarding Flock Safety and Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) Systems in Maricopa County

I, the undersigned citizen of Maricopa County, Arizona (or resident with a direct interest in the constitutional rights and privacy of the people of this County), hereby submit this formal Citizen Notice to the responsible public officials.

Purpose

This Notice is submitted to place the appropriate public officials on formal record regarding serious privacy and constitutional concerns related to the deployment and use of Flock Safety and other automated license plate reader (ALPR) camera systems.

Statement of Concerns

I formally raise the following concerns and objections:

- 1. Continuous Surveillance:** These systems continuously capture and store data about the movements of ordinary citizens who are not suspected of any crime.
- 2. Privacy Interests:** The widespread collection of location and travel data implicates significant privacy interests of the public.
- 3. Constitutional Questions:** The technology raises important questions under the Fourth Amendment and related protections against unreasonable searches, as well as questions of due process and government accountability.
- 4. Data Access and Sharing:** Concerns exist regarding how long data is retained, who may access it, under what standards, and whether adequate safeguards and oversight are in place.
- 5. Public Accountability:** Citizens have a legitimate interest in understanding the scope, policies, and oversight of these systems.

I do not assert in this document that any particular system has already been finally adjudicated to violate the Fourth Amendment. Rather, I formally request that the responsible officials carefully examine and address the serious constitutional and privacy questions these systems present.

Request for Action

I respectfully request that the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors, the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office, and all other responsible public officials review the constitutional and privacy implications of current and proposed ALPR deployments; evaluate existing policies governing data collection, retention, access, sharing, and auditing; provide clear public information regarding the use of these systems; and take appropriate steps to ensure accountability, transparency, and respect for constitutional limits. I further request a written acknowledgment of this Notice.
